

1. Test positive on rapid tests : The test result has not been confirmed by a medical professional or video consultation with a doctor yet.

<p>Actions to be taken by staffs and students</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to the Academic Information System → Report to the COVID19 section. When you experience the following symptoms: wheezing, breathing difficulties, persistent chest pain, chest tightness, unconsciousness, blue skin, lips or nail beds, inability to drink or take medicine, anuria, or significant reduction in urine output in the past 24 hours, please call the Division of Health Service 03-5743000 (Weekdays 0800-1700) or the Student Assistant Division 03-5711814 (24hrs) for help immediately. 2. Write the date, time and your name on your positive rapid test kit and take a picture of it. 3. Domestic students who reside in dormitories should generally contact their parents to take them home for home isolation. Please do not take public transportation. 4. Please abide by the principle of “one person per room” (a separate room with a bathroom). 5. For those who are unable to go home for home isolation, please contact the Division of Health Service 03-5743000 (Weekdays 0800-1700) or the Student Assistant Division 03-5711814 (24hrs) to arrange to stay at Anxin Dormitory while awaiting instructions to move to the government quarantine facility.

Ensure students and staff complete video consultations with a doctor via the EUCARE app or find one from the government list. 2. Arrange students who cannot do home isolation to stay in Anxin Dormitory temporarily. Also, register students for the government quarantine facility.

<p>Disinfection for Dormitory</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students cannot do home isolation within university’s housing. The dormitory only provides temporary accommodation for students who cannot go home for home isolation and are waiting for a group quarantine facility. 2. After a case has been a confirmed in dormitory, Division of Student Housing will arrange disinfection. Disinfect floors where confirmed cases are located, including hallways, bathrooms, and stairs.

	3. The confirmed case’s room will not be disinfected immediately. The disinfection comes two days later to protect the cleaning staff’s health interest.
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2. Confirmed Cases: Positive test result has confirmed by a doctor. Or received a positive PCR result from the hospital.

<p>Actions to be taken by staffs and students</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to the Academic Information System → Report to the COVID19 section. When you experience the following symptoms: wheezing, breathing difficulties, persistent chest pain, chest tightness, unconsciousness, blue skin, lips or nail beds, inability to drink or take medicine, anuria, or significant reduction in urine output in the past 24 hours, please call the Division of Health Service 03-5743000 (Weekdays 0800-1700) or the Student Assistant Division 03-5711814 (24hrs) for help immediately. 2. Students who reside in dormitories should generally contact their parents to take them home for home isolation. Please do not take public transportation. 3. Please abide by the principle of “one person per room” (a separate room with a bathroom). 4. After being diagnosed COVID19 positive via video consultation with a doctor, you have to fill in the close contacts on the CDC’s system within 24hrs after you received the SMS. 5. Please report your health situation on the “Survey on Epidemics” (https://reurl.cc/qO2M7D) every morning at 10am and every night at 8pm during the 7 days of home care and 7 days of self-health management. 6. Those with no symptoms who are in the self-health management period can go to work or attend classes.
<p>Actions to be taken by the Division of Health Service</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Notify confirmed cases to track their health situation everyday (7 days of home isolation and 7 days of self-health management). 2. Arrange students who cannot do home care to stay in Anxin Dormitory temporarily. Also, register students for the government quarantine facility. 3. Notify close contacts and contacts to collect their at-home rapid test kits from the Division of Health Service (3 sets free for close contacts and 1 set free for contacts).

After a case has been confirmed in dormitory, Division of Student Housing will arrange disinfection. Disinfect floors where confirmed cases are located, including hallways, bathrooms, and stairs. 3. The confirmed case's room will not be disinfected immediately. The disinfection comes two days later to protect the cleaning staff's health interest.

3. Close Contacts: Roommates contacted with a confirmed case in the two days before the confirmed case had onset of disease or tested positive (asymptomatic case).

Actions to be taken by staffs and students	Have received three vaccine doses 0+7	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete 7 Days self-initiated epidemic prevention. 2. Those in the self-initiated epidemic prevention are not allowed to go out unless necessary. A negative result from rapid test taken within two days should be presented if needs to go out to buy daily necessities. You are not allowed to return to school for classes and dormitory. 3. Please report your health situation on the "Survey on Epidemics" (https://reurl.cc/qO2M7D) every morning at 10am and every night at 8pm during the 7 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention. 4. Collect 2 at-home rapid kits from the Division of Health Service. 5. Students who reside in dormitories should, in general, go home or stay in a general hotel. You can take public transport after you have negative result on rapid test.
	have not received three vaccine doses 3+4	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete 3 days of home isolation and 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention. 2. Those in the self-initiated epidemic prevention are not allowed to go out unless necessary. A negative result from rapid test taken within two days should be presented if needs to go out to buy daily necessities. You are not allowed to return to school for classes and dormitory. 3. Please report your health situation on the "Survey on Epidemics" (https://reurl.cc/qO2M7D) every morning at 10am and every night at 8pm during the 3 days of home isolation and 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention. 4. Collect 2 at-home rapid kits from the Division of Health Service. 5. Students who reside in dormitories should, in general, go home for isolation. For those who are unable to go home for the first 3 days home isolation, please contact the Division of Health Service 03-5743000 (Weekdays 0800-1700) or the Student Assistant Division 03-5711814 (24 hrs) to stay at Anxin Dormitory while awaiting instructions to move to the quarantine hotel. For the 4 days self-initiated epidemic prevention, you can take public transport to go home or stay in general hotel after you have negative result on rapid test. 6. Please abide by the principle of "one person per room" (a separate room with a

Notify close contacts to track their health situation every day (3 days of home isolation and 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention) or 7 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention. 2. Arrange students who cannot do home isolation to stay in Anxin Dormitory temporarily. Also, register students for the quarantine hotel. 3. Provide 2 at-home rapid kits to each close contacts.

After a case has been a confirmed in dormitory, Division of Student Housing will arrange disinfection. Disinfect floors where confirmed cases are located, including hallways, bathrooms, and stairs. 3. The confirmed case's room will not be disinfected immediately. The disinfection comes two days later to protect the cleaning staff's health interest.

4. Contacts: Either party didn't wear a mask in activities, who had a 15-minute or more exposure with confirmed cases.

Actions to be taken by staffs and students	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Collect one free at-home rapid tests from the Division of Health Service. 2. Those with no symptoms can go back to work or attend classes if they have negative result on rapid test. 3. If you exhibit COVID-19 symptoms such as fevers, coughs, diarrhea, loss of smell or taste, or respiratory symptoms. Please do at-home rapid antigen tests first. If Test positive on rapid tests, please get it confirmed by medical professional or video consultation with a doctor. If you need to seek medical attention immediately, mask must be worn. And you must actively inform the doctor of your contact history. Please do not take public transport to the hospital. 4. Please find a well-ventilated room when you do the rapid test. If there are no suitable

Actions to be taken by the Division of Health Service	1. Notify contacts to do self-health monitoring. 2. Notify contacts to collect one free at-home rapid test kits from the Division of Health Service
Course Arrangement and Student Attendance	Those with no symptoms can go back to work or attend classes if they have negative result on rapid test.
Accommodation and Disinfection	Please sanitize your room by yourself. You can ask the Division of Student Housing for bleach of the appropriate ratio.

5. Arrivals: Students and staff returning from foreign countries

Actions to be taken by staffs and students	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For current students, please complete the Exit Declaration form before leaving Taiwan. 2. Fill in your information in quarantine system for entry within 48hrs before arriving in Taiwan. 3. Fill in the 1st Survey on Epidemics (https://reurl.cc/qO2M7D) at least 24hrs before arriving in Taiwan. 4. Please report your health situation on the “Survey on Epidemics” (https://reurl.cc/qO2M7D) every morning at 10am and every night at 8pm during 3 days of Designated Residence Isolation (Home Isolation, Quarantine Hotel) and 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention. 5. For the 3 days of home quarantine, you must abide by the “one person per residence” policy or stay in a quarantine hotel. For the 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention, you are allowed to move to one person per room, in principle, should have a separated bathroom. But you still cannot stay at a general hotel. 6. Those in the self-initiated epidemic prevention period are not allowed to go out unless necessary. A negative result from rapid test taken within two days should be presented if an arrival needs to go out to work or buy daily necessities. You are not allowed to return to school for classes and dormitory.
Actions to be taken by the Division of Health Service	Notify arrivals to track their health situation every day during 3 days of home quarantine and 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention.
Course Arrangement and Student Attendance	<p>Students: Email lecturers for COVID leave and discuss about course arrangements and other self-study alternatives.</p> <p>Lecturers:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student in home isolation or in self-initiated epidemic prevention, student is not allowed to come to school. Lecturer either plan through the e-learning platform or contact student via email directly about how to proceed. Departments shall assist as well. 2. Accommodation	School dormitories are not open for quarantine and self-initiated epidemic prevention.
